- A victim's risk of being injured or killed increases by as much as 75% when leaving a violent relationship.
- Shelter with comprehensive services is imperative for victims to remain safe after leaving.
- Providing safety planning, shelter and meeting the basic needs of victims of domestic violence and their children is vital, but Friendship Home does so much more...

Friendship Home serves over 1,500 victims each year, over half of them children.
